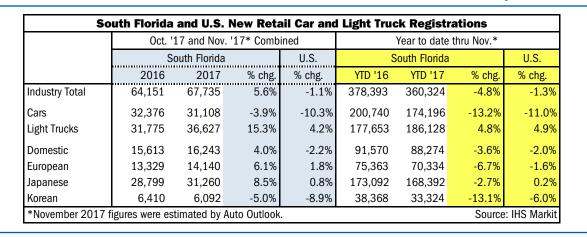
New retail light vehicle registrations in the four county area market declined 4.8% during the first 11 months of this year versus a year earlier. The U.S. market fell 1.3%.

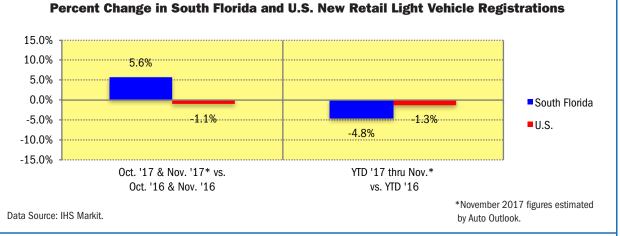
Quick Facts

Light truck registrations were up 4.8% so far this year, while passenger cars were down 13.2%

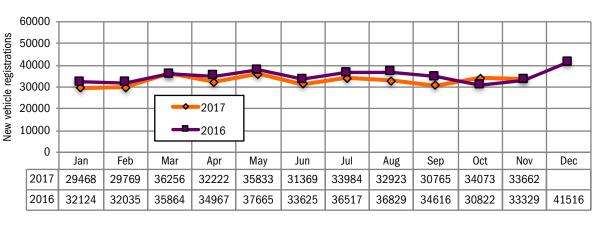
Area SUV market share increased sharply during 2017, while the Luxury and Sports Car segment had the largest decline.

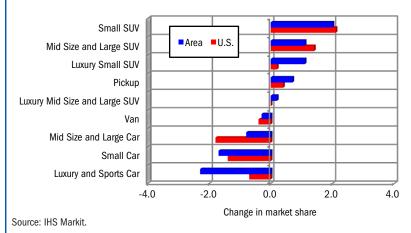
