New retail light vehicle registrations in the four county area market declined 6.7% during the first nine months of this year versus a year earlier. The U.S. market fell 0.3%.

Quick Facts

The area market is expected to post gains in October and November due to replacement demand for vehicles that were damaged as a result of Hurricane Irma.


Toyota, Honda, Chevrolet, Nissan, and Ford are market share leaders in the area. Lexus, Mercedes, Honda, VW, and BMW had much higher market shares in the area than in the state.

South Florida Monthly New Retail Light Vehicle Registrations




