## Comprehensive information on the South Florida new vehicle market

## Quick Facts

New retail light vehicle registrations in the four county area market declined 6.7\% during the first nine months of this year versus a year earlier. The U.S. market fell 0.3\%.

The area market is expected to post gains in October and November due to replacement demand for vehicles that were damaged as a result of Hurricane Irma.

Toyota, Honda,
Chevrolet, Nissan, and Ford are market share leaders in the area. Lexus, Mercedes, Honda, VW, and BMW had much higher market shares in the area than in the state.

All data represents new retail registrations in the South Florida Area (Broward, Dade, Monroe, and Palm Beach counties) and excludes fleet transactions. Please keep in mind that monthly registration figures can occasionally be subject to fluctuations, resulting in over or under estimation of actual results. This usually occurs due to processing delays by governmental agencies. For this reason, the year-to-date figures will typically be more reflective of market results. Green shaded areas in tables represent the top ten ranked brands.
